



Alliance Medical Education Scholarship (AMES) Fund

Multiple scholarships of \$2,500 each will be awarded

The Pennsylvania Medical Society Alliance established this scholarship fund in April 2000 to support Pennsylvania residents enrolled in a Pennsylvania medical school. The Alliance ceased operations in June 2019; however, their legacy and commitment to the education of medical students continue on through this scholarship.

Eligibility for scholarship applicants:

- Applicant must be a United States citizen.
- Applicant must be a Pennsylvania resident for at least 12 months prior to registering as a medical student (not including time spent attending an undergraduate or graduate school).
- Applicant must be a second- or third-year medical student.
- Applicant must be enrolled full-time at an accredited Pennsylvania medical school.

Applicant must use the Scholarship Application Portal to submit the following:

- A completed scholarship application.
- Two reference letters, from persons other than family members, documenting the applicant's integrity, interpersonal skills, and potential as a future physician.
- A letter, on school letterhead, from the applicant's medical school verifying that he/she is enrolled full time as a second- or third-year medical student.

Online applications open July 1

Application must be submitted by September 30 of the current year.

Applicants will be notified of the committee's decision in November of the current year.
